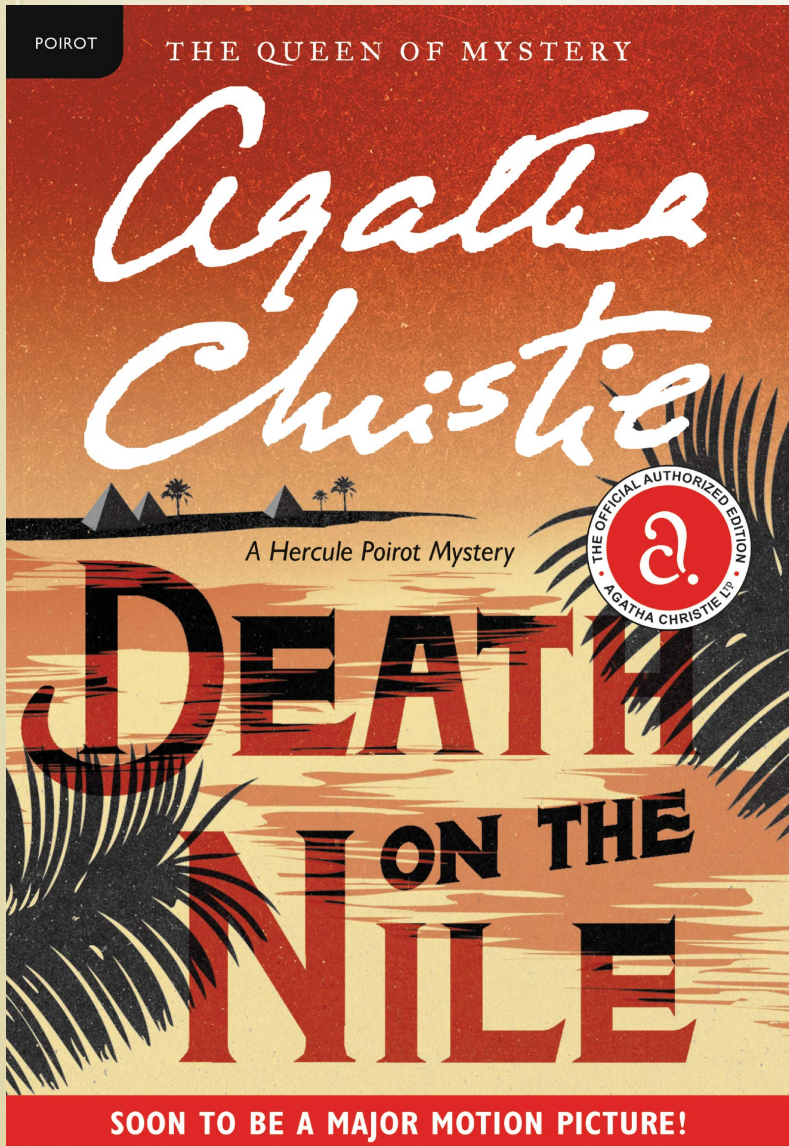


WHAT WE ARE READING
