1. When posting on the discussion forum, select “post privately” if you want to remain anonymous.
false—Post anonymously. Anonymous posts and responses will be seen by other students and other students can respond and follow up. Private posts will only be seen by the course staff.
2. It is considered a violation of academic integrity to post part of a homework solution or a homework hint.

3. A private post will never be made public. **false—We reserve the right to make private posts public if we feel the class would benefit. If we do so, we will make your post anonymous.**
4. All course announcements will be posted on Canvas. **false—We are not using Canvas this semester. Announcements will be posted on the discussion forum.**
5. Students may request deadline extensions in any multiple of 24 hours (up to a 72-hour limit for the semester) for too much work in other courses. **true**
6. Students may collaborate with a partner on homework assignments. **true—Please form a group in CMS if you do.**
7. In homework questions, if you are asked only to “show” and not to “prove,” a formal proof is not required.
false—“show,” “argue,” “demonstrate,” and all similar verbs mean “prove formally.”
8. On the homework, scanned or photographed handwritten solutions are acceptable. **false—Please typeset your solutions. L^AT_EX templates are available on the handouts page.**
