The goal of this assignment is to make you familiar with the experience of a worker (a “turker”) on Amazon Mechanical Turk (MTurk). As you do this assignment please make a mental note of which tasks were fun or interesting and/or which were the opposite, as well as how much pay you received for each task, how long it took, and whether you felt fairly compensated. This will help you answer the questions at the end of this assignment.

1. Sign up to be a worker on MTurk by going to www.mturk.com. It may take 1-2 days for your account to be approved. Please contact the instructor if you are unable to create an account.
2. Work through at least 50 tasks. You can simply pick tasks that sound interesting, or pose this as a challenge to yourself to make as much money as you can or get the highest hourly pay rate that you can.
3. Please submit (short) write-up with answers to the following questions:
 1. Did you have trouble signing up? If so, explain.
 2. How many assignments did you complete?
 3. On what basis did you select tasks (remember, you only need to give a *short* answer)?
 4. How much money did you make?
 5. How much time did you spend working?
 6. What task gave you the most money?
 7. Did any of your HITs get rejected? If so, what reason was given?
 8. What was your reaction to being an MTurk worker?
